

PROCTORIAL NOTICE

DISRUPTION OF LECTURES AND SEMINARS

Members of the University are reminded of Regulation 2 of the General Regulations for Discipline¹ which requires members of the University to conform with section 43 of the Education (No 2) Act 1986:

- (a) freedom of speech is to be safeguarded on University premises
- (b) disruption of lectures, seminars or other authorized activities is forbidden
- (c) due notice of meetings, or any other gatherings, is required.

Members of the University are also reminded that it is forbidden to consume food or drink in lecture rooms.

Members of the University are further reminded of Regulation 9 of the General Regulations for Discipline²:

All members of the University shall state their names and the College to which they belong when asked by a Proctor or Pro-Proctor or by any other person in authority in the University or in any of the Colleges in the University.

The Proctors may take disciplinary action against any member of the University who does not comply with the General Regulations for Discipline.
