

The Cambridge Society is a membership organisation for Cambridge people. It has some 7000 members worldwide. It keeps members in touch with the University's developments, achievements and needs, through its magazine *CAMBRIDGE*, and through events organised centrally and through its network of Branches and associated Societies.

The Society's role of supporting the University is in accordance with its charitable Objects:

'the advancement of the welfare and interests of the University of Cambridge as a place of education, religion, learning and research, including:

- a) the encouragement of closer relations between resident and non-resident members of the University by fostering interests which they have in common;
- b) keeping members of the Society informed of events in the University and of any questions which concern its welfare;
- c) assisting those who are concerned with the preservation and enhancement of the beauties and development of the amenities of the University, its buildings and monuments;
- d) associating as may be considered desirable with any organisations having the like or similar objects (*such as the Cambridge Foundation*).
