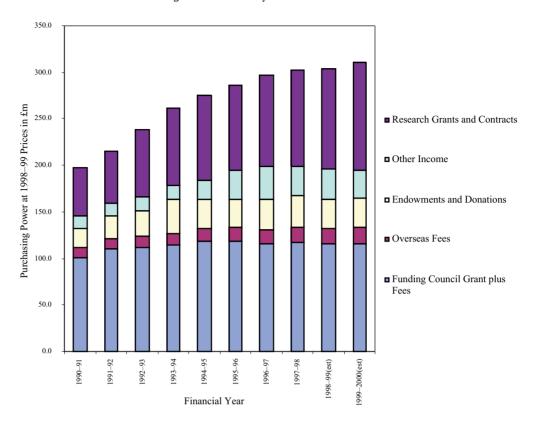
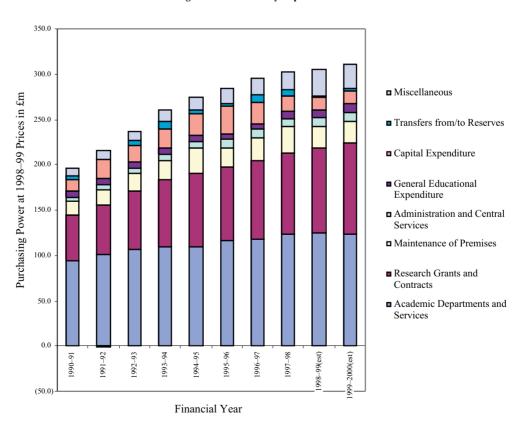
Purchasing Power of University Income 1990-2000



Purchasing Power of University Expenditure

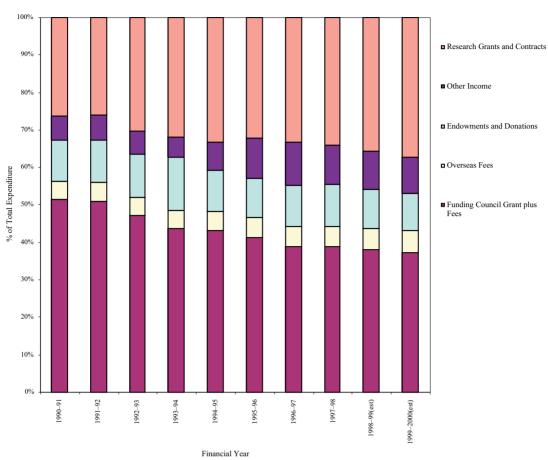

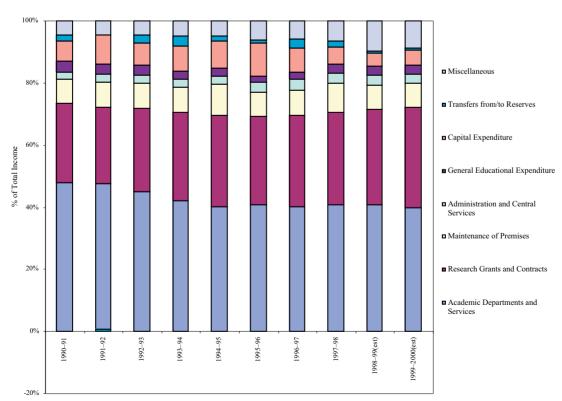
