Please note that in contrast to previous editions of this Reporter Special, the College of application in the data above is defined as the applicant's first choice College (or, in the case of an Open applicant, the College to which the applicant was assigned) regardless of subsequent transfers through the pools. Last year's percentages (shown in italics) have been recalculated on this basis so as to be comparable with other published data.

The figures include only those applicants who applied from a school or college in the UK, some of these will be overseas students, and show the percentage of applicants and acceptances by College from the maintained sector including FE institutions.
