

## **Classical Tripos, Parts IB and II, 2016**

The Faculty Board of Classics give notice that, with effect from the examination to be held in 2016, the prescribed texts for certain papers of the Classical Tripos will be as specified below:

### PART IB

Paper 6: Latin Literature, Topic 2 Seneca in poetry and prose. The prescribed texts under Schedule B: Seneca to be given as *Phaedra*, *De clementia*, *De ira* 1, *Epistulae morales* 1 (=letters 1–12).

### PART II

Paper A4: Greek and Latin textual criticism and transmission of texts for 2016. The prescribed portion of Catullus [given as poems 13–17, 21–6, 51–62] are amended to:

13–17, 21–6, 62, 64 lines 1–302

The number of lines is slightly reduced and the metre is easier (poem 64 is in dactylic hexameters), but the length of the last 304 lines is longer.
