


Q2. Did you vote in the election of the Chancellor in 2011?




Q3. How likely are you to vote in a future election of the Chancellor?




Q4. How likely are you to make or support a nomination in a future election of the Chancellor?




Q5. Assuming you vote in the next election of the Chancellor, which method of voting do you expect to use?






Q6. Do you agree with (b) automatic election of the University Council's nominee if no candidate is nominated?








