1. Definitions

In this scheme:

“the charity” means the charity identified at the beginning of this scheme

“the Commission” means the Charity Commission for England and Wales.

“the existing trusts” means the Regulations set out in Chapter XII of the Statutes and Ordinances of University of Cambridge.

2. Administration

The charity is to be administered in accordance with its existing trusts as altered or affected by this scheme.

3. Alteration of existing trusts

a) Clause 1 of the existing trusts to be deleted and replaced with:

1. The sum received by the University from the Chuan Lyu Foundation shall form a fund, called the Chuan Lyu Fund for Taiwan Studies, the income of which shall be used to support teaching and research in Taiwan Studies.

b) Clause 3 of the existing trusts to be deleted and replaced with:

3. The income of the Fund shall be applied at the discretion of the Managers towards any or all of the following:

(a) to provide the stipend, national insurance, and pension contributions of one or more Chuan Lyu Research Fellows who shall engage in teaching and research in the field of Taiwan Studies;

(b) to provide the subsistence allowance and travel costs of a Chuan Lyu Senior Visiting Scholar who shall offer lectures and engage in research in their area of expertise within the field of Taiwan Studies;

(c) to provide the subsistence allowance and travel costs of one or more Chuan Lyu Researchers who shall offer lectures and engage in research in their area of expertise within the field of Taiwan Studies;

(d) to facilitate access to Taiwanese institutions and resources and promote scholarly exchange between scholars in Taiwan Studies at the University and other institutions;

(e) to fund library resources in support of the study of Taiwan.

4. Questions relating to the Scheme

The Commission may decide any question put to it concerning:

(1) the interpretation of this scheme; or

(2) the propriety or validity of anything done or intended to be done under it.
